10. In the midst of the controversy, does Jesus show any sign from backing down?

John 8:12-59

1. What does Jesus say in the beginning of this passage?

2. What do the Pharisees argue?

3. Where was Jesus when He taught this?

John 8:54-59 (Again)

1. What does Jesus say about His relationship to God in verses 54-56?

2. Why are the religious leaders so upset?

3. When Jesus says, "Before Abraham was, I am," do you understand what He is saying?

4. Why did the Jews want to stone Jesus upon hearing this?
