3. The man's response (worship) prompts Jesus to re-state His purpose on earth. What is it, according to verse 39

John 10:1-21 1. Why do you think Jesus directly heals the man with blindness but uses a parable to address the spiritual blindness of the Pharisees? 2. Summarize the story as best as you're able. 3. What do you think Jesus' story has to do with the spiritual blindness of the Pharisees? 4. What is the Pharisees' reaction to this parable? 5. Why do you think the Pharisees could not be made to see that Jesus was who He said He was? John 9:1-5 (Again) 1. What do the disciples ask upon seeing the blind man? 2. What is Jesus' immediate concern? 3. Verse four says that who must do the Father's work? 4. Who, in these verses, is "we"?

5. If Jesus heals the blind man, why do you think He says "we"?
5. Why does Jesus inform His disciples that He will be going away, about it being day, about how He won't be around forever, and how a time will come when "no one can work"?
